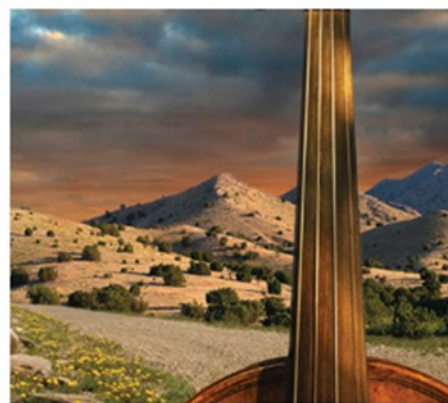

39th Season

The Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival offers an exciting selection of works performed by some of today's foremost musicians on the chamber music stage during its 39th season this July 17 - August 22, 2011.

This summer, the Festival's Artist-in-Residence, renowned soprano Dawn Upshaw, performs in five concerts of three programs, including a performance of Osvaldo Golijov's autobiographical song cycle *Ayre*, written especially for her. The Festival continues its role as a noteworthy contributor to the contemporary chamber music repertoire with the addition of three new co-commissions by internationally acclaimed composers Christopher Rouse, Marc-André Dalbavie and Sean Shepherd. In conjunction with the performances, the Festival presents pre-concert talks with all three composers open to the public. Through its *American Composer Residency* program, this summer the Festival also offers private master classes with Mr. Rouse and Mr. Shepherd to area conservatory/college music students. The *American Composer Residency* program is made possible with a grant from the National Endowment of the Arts' *American Masterpieces: Chamber Music* initiative.

Continuing to program timeless masterpieces and rarely heard gems alongside compelling new works from notable living composers, the Festival presents over 90 works by numerous composers including Bach, Beethoven, Debussy, Dvořák, Erb, Eötvös, Fauré, Janáček, Penderecki, Piazzolla, Martinů, Mendelssohn, Neikrug, Ravel, Schafer, Schumann, Tchaikovsky, Telemann and Zelenka, to name a few. The Festival presents 72 artists and five ensembles in over 80 concerts, recitals, master classes, youth concerts and open rehearsals.

Sixteen musicians and two ensembles make their Festival debuts, and returning audience favorites include pianist Inon Barnatan, flutist Tara Helen O'Connor, cellists Felix Fan and Eric Kim, the Orion String Quartet and the Shanghai Quartet, among others. Pianist Cecile Licad joins the Festival roster, replacing Yuja Wang. Among those making their Festival debuts this summer are pianists Gilbert Kalish and Joyce Yang, guitarist Claudio Ragazzi, harpist Bridget Kibbey, accordion player Michael Ward-Bergeman, the Calder Quartet and Time for Three.

Concerts take place in Santa Fe at the intimate, historic St. Francis Auditorium at the New Mexico Museum of Art, and the Lensic Performing Arts Center. The Festival's Wednesday evening Albuquerque mini-series takes place this year at Albuquerque Academy's Simms Auditorium (July 20, 27 and August 3 at 7:30 pm).

A few of the season's highlights:

The Shanghai Quartet perform Dvořák's *Piano Quintet in A Major* with pianist Kuok-Wai Lio, and Penderecki's *String Quartet No. 3 "Leaves from an Unwritten Diary."* Allan Vogel, Robert Ingliss, Theodore Soluri, Kathleen McIntosh and Marji Danilow perform Zelenka's *Trio Sonata No. 1 in F Major* in the opening concerts (July 17 & 18);

Artist-in-Residence Dawn Upshaw performs Bach's *Cantata No. 199, "Mein Herze schwimmt im Blut"*, *BWV 199* in her first 2011 concert (July 23). The program also includes British violinist Daniel Hope in Bach's *Violin Concerto in A Minor*;

The Johannes String Quartet performs Webern's *Five Movements, Op. 5* and Janacek's "Intimate Letters" on the Week Two noon concert (July 26);

The Calder Quartet, making their Festival debut this season, perform composer Christopher Rouse's Festival co-commission, *String Quartet No. 3* (July 28 & 29);

Guitarist Claudio Ragazzi, accordion player Michael Ward-Bergeman and bass player Mark Dresser perform a World Music concert (July 30);

Golijov's *Ayre* performed by Artist-in-Residence soprano Dawn Upshaw and eleven festival artists (July 31 & August 1);

Flutist Joshua Smith and harpsichordist Kathleen McIntosh perform Bach's sonatas in B Minor, E Major, E Minor and A Major (August 6);

Pianist Joyce Yang makes her Festival solo recital debut (August 9);

Festival premieres of co-commissions by Marc-André Dalbavie (August 10, 11 & 12) and Sean Shepherd (August 11 & 12; world premiere is August 11), plus a pre-concert talk with both composers (August 12); Dalbavie will also participate in pre-concert talks on August 10 & 11;

David Shifrin and the Orion String Quartet perform the Festival premiere of Marc Neikrug's *Clarinet Quintet* (August 15);

Ida Kavafian, Peter Wiley and Anne-Marie McDermott perform the complete Beethoven Trios over the course of two nights (August 17 & 18);

Time for Three performs in concert at the Lensic Performing Arts Center (August 19);

Piazzolla's *The Four Seasons of Buenos Aires* on August 13 and Vivaldi's *Four Seasons* on August 20;

The season-ending concert (August 22) includes pianist Cecile Licad and Victor Santiago Asuncion performing Bartók's *Sonata for Two Pianos & Percussion* with percussionists Jeffrey Milarsky and David Tolen.

On July 14, 2011 the ever popular Annual Chefs' Gala will take place in two locations. The concert, featuring pianist Kuok-Wai Lio and the Shanghai Quartet, will be held at the First Presbyterian Church in Santa Fe. Champagne and hors d'oeuvres, followed by the festive dinner featuring the finest chefs in Northern New Mexico, takes place at the Santa Fe Community Convention Center located across the street from the church.

Radio personality Kerry Frumkin hosts the series with commentary from Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival artistic director Marc Neikrug. The Festival is also broadcast in New Zealand and Israel.

Founded in 1972, the Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival, one of the nation's oldest, is among the world's pre-eminent music festivals, and renowned for its innovative spirit, inspirational performances and commitment to artistic excellence.

A significant contributor to contemporary chamber music repertoire, this season the Festival brings its number of commissioned works to 57.

The Festival maintains a strong tradition of community service, including the *Music in Our Schools* program - a music education series for grades K-8 in the Santa Fe Public Schools.
